

Notification of Sanction

- AWA was made aware on April 22, 2022 of WCH publishing the sanctions imposed on Charles Mather of Calgary
- Currently the published summary has a typo with the correction to be "A hearing was held before and Independent Arbitrator on March 28, 2021"
- The published summary makes references to the old WCH policy sections active at the time of the breach
- A communication will be sent out shortly to AWA members to alert them of the sanction

- Sanctions directly impacting the AWA are the following:
 - Banned from coaching any weightlifting athlete under the age of 25 without supervision until Nov 2025



New Memberships

- · New membership categories introduced
 - · Help us understand and track coaches/technical officials for promotion and development opportunities
 - Coach/team registration allows us to post/promote our provincial NCCP coaches on the AWA web site
- Athlete memberships
 - Senior [\$70], Junior [free], Youth [free]
 - Required to register for competitions, unchanged from before
- Coach registration [\$35]
 - Required to receive credentials for access to warm up/competition field of play
 - Must be NCCP "trained" or "certified" to apply
 - Entitled to declare unique club name or associate with an existing club
 - Current coaches: please register now to give us time to verify NCCP status and issue coach credentials for the season
- Technical official registration [free]
 - Required to receive credentials for access officials only areas
 - Must have completed the level technical official clinic or hold current TO levels 1-4
 - Current officials: please register now to give us time to verify TO status and issue TO credentials for the season

- All Western PSO's agreed to move westerns to late November to set up biannual training schedule
- Alberta hosting November 29, 2022
- Looking for 3-5 people to run organizing committee
- · Activities include:
 - Competition and hotel venues (may be co-located)
 - Organizing of sponsors, vendors, photographer, volunteers, apparel, food/refreshments, equipment sourcing/transport, etc.
 - Innovate on ways to generate more interest, increase visibility, grant applications, improve competition/viewer experience, etc.
 - · Casino funds available to supplement costs of hosting

- Held May 20-22, 2022 in Kelowna, British Columbia
- Final entries to be submitted April 25, 2022
- Team of 31: 20 athletes, 7 coaches, 5 officials
- Funding plan:

• All athletes: \$230 entry

Jr/Yth Non-wildcard athletes: \$230 entry, 50% travel cost @\$375
 AWA selected coaches/lead: \$150 entry, 100% travel cost @\$750

• Additional coaches: no funding

• AWA selected TOs: \$50 entry, 100% travel cost@\$750

• Additional TOs: \$50 entry

- Considering \$78,000 collected from the recent casino
 - 50% allocated to Sr and split between Westerns/Sr Nationals needing to cover 2 years
 - Target per Sr competitions is \$9750
 - November 2022 Westerns in Alberta can receive \$6775 in supplement
 - Sr Nationals and Westerns 2023 allocated \$9750 each
 - Cannot assume AWA to pay for athlete entry fees in future competitions

Jr Nationals Team

- Held June 4-5, 2022 in La Prairie, Quebec
- Preliminary entries to be submitted May 8, 2022
- 16 athletes currently qualified and being contacted to collect information with qualification period ending May 1, 2022
- Potential for up to 4 wildcard spots
- Considering the \$78,000 collected from the casino, \$13,000 allocated to Jr. Nationals
 - Jr/Yth funding of 50% of casino value
 - The 2 years of funding spans 3 Jr Nationals June 2022 (delayed), January 2023, January 2024
- · Current projections for costs are as follows
 - 16 qualified athletes, 0 wildcards
 - If qualified athletes withdraw, wildcard athletes can fill slots
 - 100% travel cost estimated at \$750 (without vehicle allowance)
 - Athletes with qualification totals above Prov Class 1 offered 50% travel cost reimbursement
 - Team vehicle rental and gas estimated at \$570/vehicle, 2 required
